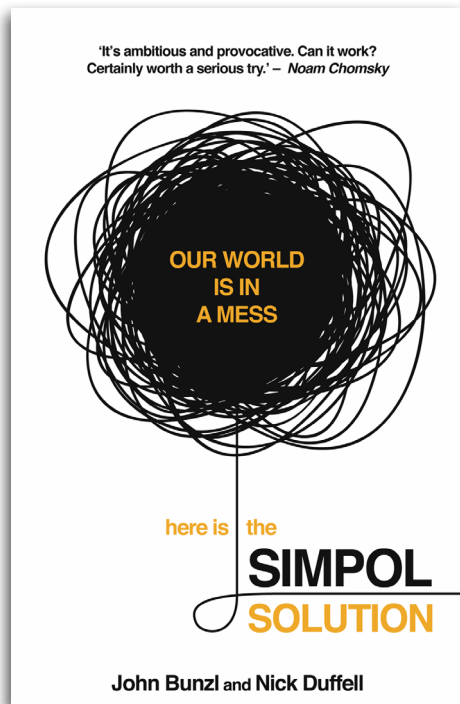

The Book

The SIMPOL Solution explains why our efforts to deal with these problems are failing, and proposes new ways of thinking which can help us tackle them.
